ORDINANCE 1985-16

An Ordinance Adopting the Uniform Act Regulating Traffic on Highways;
Providing for Careless Driving and Penalties Therefore;
as an Emergency Ordinance

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF ROLLING HILLS:

Section 1

§15-1-120 W.S., 1977 Republished Ed, and §31-77 through and including 31-237 of the W.S. 1957, and amendments thereto, as renumbered §31-5-101 through and including 31-5-1214 W.S., 1977 Republished Ed, and any subsequent amendments thereto, being the Uniform Act Regulating Traffic on Highways, except such sections as may from time to time be deleted by ordinance, are hereby adopted by reference and incorporated as a part of the ordinances of Rolling Hills, as if said act were set out in full herein. Specifically adopted is W.S. §31-4-103, a statute requiring proof of liability insurance.

Section 2

For the purpose of this ordinance, the terms "highway" and "highway of the state" as used in such Uniform Act shall be construed to mean and include the streets, alleys, driveways, or any other piece of property on which a motor vehicle can be operated upon, within the corporate boundaries of Rolling Hills.

Section 3

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle without due caution and circumspection or at a speed or in such a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property. Any person who operates a vehicle in such a manner shall be guilty of careless driving.

Section 4

Any violation of this ordinance or any portion of the Uniform Act incorporated herein shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by fine not to exceed \$750.

Section 5

This ordinance is hereby proclaimed to be an emergency and shall be passed in accordance thereto.
